- 3. Update from Subcommittee Teams
  - a. Enhancing VWC training consistency
    - i. Brian Nagle with be speaking at IVWA conference in October to discuss bridging gap and getting training consistencies
    - ii. Training module recordings for state-wide access
      - 1. 10-12 presentations have all been approved and accredited
      - 2. Will serve as training options for VWCs around the state
      - 3. Will be able to be accessed virtually
    - iii. Sherri Cameron mentioned she would get with IPAA about trainings on their end
  - b. Bridging the gap between sentencing and post-conviction/appellate victim services
    - i. Tammara, Lauren and Brittney to get together to discuss VINEWatch
    - ii. Parole and IDOC have each created a letter to send to victims when resident goes through RDU
      - 1. Brittney and Lauren will meet a deputy chief at IDOC to connect with RDU folks and explain to them what and why we need this information
    - iii. Victim Services dashboard created by IDOC to help assist in noticing if victims are missing on offenders who need that alert
    - iv. Apology letter bank
      - 1. Common among various DOC departments around the country
      - 2. Still getting input from IDOC legal on NCO/CPO portion
      - 3. Victims would be notified about the program and told they can reach out to see if they have letter(s) from their offender
    - v. Restorative Voices Program
      - 1. Being offered at the rider facility, MVTC
      - 2. Educates residents on impact of various crimes on victims, victim empathy, etc.
      - 3. Final portion of class is for resident to write an apology letter to their victim(s)
  - c. One-stop shop for resources
    - i. Working on website --- AGs victim services website (ag.idaho.gov/victims)

- ii. Hover over map was too expensive but there is a district map on there for folks to see what district they fall in
- iii. Hope is to get a QR code that can route folks to the website
  - 1. Stickers, cards, etc....
- iv. Discussed looking at other VWC websites to get an idea of what info
  - Possibly partnering with council on DV to add list of VWC in each district to their website
  - 2. Holly will discuss with Brian Nagle about IPAA assisting with having an area for one-stop shop victim services
